

## CFWC FUNDS AND HOW THEY ARE USED

### Helen Tunkis memorial Fund: G256

Mrs. Tunkis was CFWC President in 1972-1974. Funds were donated in her memory for many years and not designated for any special purpose. To date no expenses have been taken out of this account; it is not a large sum. Finance Committee will be working on designating a purpose for this account.

### Kathleen Wylie Bequest Fund: G262

Mrs. Wylie was CFWC President in 1968-1970. Upon her death, she left a bequest to CFWC including a portfolio of oil stocks. In 1995 it was voted to divest the corporation of all of these stocks, except one section was held out—so we still get a small dividend check quarterly on these shares, and this money is deposited into G262. The original fund money is invested in U. S. Bank. When the interest is received, it is transferred to G262. This money is used for hosting GFWC visiting officers and chairmen when they come to speak at conventions or meetings.

### Jo Windsor Memorial Fund: G254

This was named for a former office secretary of CFWC. The funds were donated in her memory, and then have been added to by clubs through the years. The money in the fund was to be used for office equipment. However, since we no longer need to furnish the headquarters office or purchase office equipment, we have been using it to purchase computers and programs for the Finance Committee to keep their financial records.

### Caroline Severance Endowment Fund: G259

*(Itinerary Fund)*

Caroline Severance was a close friend of Susan B. Anthony, and moved west with her family in the late 1800's. They lived just off Adams Blvd. in Los Angeles, and she continued to volunteer in suffragette movements. She was one of the founders of the CFWC, after attending the Columbia Exposition World's Fair in Chicago in 1893. Mrs. Severance is now buried in a cemetery on Adams Blvd. near Hoover Street. (This was on the Huell Howser's California Gold show). Her fortune was given to the CFWC as an Endowment Fund that is to be kept invested. Part of this is also the current Foundation Fund. Dividends and interest from this fund shall be credited to the General Fund and are to be used to carry the message of federation to clubs by members of the Executive Board for itinerary, Area Seminars and other means of communication. It is also used for dues for outside organizations for State Chairmen, the Western Region States Conference, the LEADS candidates, and other projects to promote federation.
